### **About the Program**

“Empowering the Gazan Female Student” is a developmental program launched by Isnad Foundation for Supporting Palestinian Student. It aims to enhance the capabilities of outstanding university female students, empowering them academically, professionally, and in research, and providing them with the tools and opportunities that enable them to take part in leadership pathways within their communities.

The program is specifically directed toward:

- Bachelor’s degree students (academically distinguished)
- Master’s and PhD students in scientific and humanities fields with societal impact

## What Does the Program Offer?

### Academic and Skills Development

- Specialized professional training
- Connecting students with the job market

- Meetings with women leaders
- Empowerment and discussion circles
- Building a graduates' network to create sustainable support



## Available Support Mechanisms for Women's Organizations

### Student Sponsorship – (Educational and Professional Support)

Includes:

- Support for university tuition fees
- Monthly stipend
- Sponsorship of a research project or training
- Academic and developmental follow-up

### Institutional Partnership

For women's organizations seeking to create meaningful impact:

- Sponsoring a full cohort of female students
- Supporting the establishment of a laboratory or training hall
- Sponsoring a scientific day or a women's conference for students

- Creating an active and strong women's network that drives development in Gaza
